8.	What did Abigail drink during the midnight dancing party? Why?
9.	What has happened between Abigail and John Proctor in the past? Why does Abigail hate John Proctor's wife?
10.	Who is Rebecca Nurse?
11.	Who is Giles Corey? Why is he concerned about his wife, Martha?
12.	The Putnams support Reverend Parris. John Proctor, Rebecca Nurse, and Giles Corey do not. Why is the
